

In response to the improvement plan for the courtyard, common areas, and dormitory rooms of Dormitories C and D, temporary requisition and construction activities cannot be accommodated. Please refrain from applying for dormitories.

Announcement for the Registration of Dormitory Beds and Computer Lottery for the 113th Academic Year

Please read the Dormitory Regulations carefully. If your daily schedule cannot comply with the regulations, it is recommended not to apply to avoid violations. Severe violations may result in eviction.

I. Lottery Attention:

Application Period: From 12:00 on March 7 to 12:00 on March 13, 113th academic year.

Applicants: All registered students of the university (including those on leave or delayed graduation).

Note: Guarantee students (excluding students reported by the Counseling Center as "Hui Xin" and those reported by the Sports Section as "sports protection") must also apply for bed spaces during the application period to secure a bed. Failure to apply will be considered as giving up the bed space. Guarantee students who violate dormitory regulations with more than 10 points will lose their bed space guarantee and must apply through the lottery like regular students.

Lottery Results: **Tentatively announced on March 29, 113th academic year, at 12:00 (subject to the actual announcement by the Housing Service Section).**

Application Method: Please apply online through the Academic Information System - "Dormitory Application Status" during the application period. (The system will be open for applications during the application period).

Special Notes:

(1) Graduate students and undergraduate students can apply for Graduate Dormitory, air-conditioned rooms in the undergraduate dormitory, and general rooms in the undergraduate dormitory according to personal preferences.

(2) Guarantee students can only apply for accommodation according to their level. Due to the plan for the 113th academic year to transform some general rooms in the undergraduate dormitory into air-conditioned rooms, bed types will be adjusted based on the order of preferences, focusing on providing general rooms and adjusting based on the actual number of available bed spaces. (Undergraduate guarantee students cannot apply for the graduate student dormitory. If you want to stay in the graduate student dormitory, please go to the Housing Service Section to give up the guarantee before the application deadline. Apply through the lottery like regular students.)

To meet the needs of students and parents, funds have been actively sought by the Director of Academic Affairs. There is a chance that undergraduate dormitories will be fully renovated into air-conditioned rooms in the 113th academic year. "If a student was originally assigned to a general room in the undergraduate dormitory but changes to an air-conditioned room when moving in, they must pay the difference."

II. Confirmation of Accommodation for Successful Lottery Winners (including guarantee students):

Successful lottery winners (including guarantee students) must fill out the form for "Confirmation of Accommodation for the 113th Academic Year" on the system announcement of the Academic Information System – Student and Visitor Simple Version – System Announcement **from 12:00 on April 1 to 12:00 on April 8**. Failure to do so by the deadline will be considered as giving up the bed space, and it will be filled by the waiting list in order.

If, due to personal reasons or other factors, one cannot move into the dormitory, please notify via EMAIL (cmchang@ncnu.edu.tw) by 17:00 on May 24. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the NT\$2,000 deposit, and no future accommodation applications will be accepted.

III. Lottery Explanation:

Object of Dormitory Bed Guarantee:

- (1) Freshmen of the first year of the undergraduate department for the 113th academic year.
- (2) First-year master's and doctoral students (excluding part-time master's students).
- (3) Transfer students in the academic year.
- (4) Students with disabilities.
- (5) Low-income households and middle-to-low-income households.
- (6) Overseas students.
- (7) Public-funded students.
- (8) Students who will assume the position of dormitory autonomous cadres in the academic year.
- (9) Dormitory public service students.
- (10) Student dormitory appeal evaluation committee members.

Rules for Waiting List and Bed Allocation: Students on the waiting list should pay attention to the announcement on the Housing Service Section website. The first round of waiting list announcements is scheduled for April 29, 113th academic year. Bed spaces will be filled in order according to the waiting list number. Waiting list students must register "Confirmation of Accommodation" online within the waiting list announcement period to qualify for accommodation.

Note 1: The waiting list number will continue to be used until June 17, 113th academic year, after which it will be invalidated.

Note 2: For those willing to wait until the start of the next academic year for bed space, please check the announcement on the Housing Service Section website for bed space application after June 18.

Note 3: Violating accommodation students who fail to complete the service hours deduction within the deadline, if they retain the lottery accommodation qualification, will cancel the accommodation qualification for the 113th academic year.

Note 4: Students who violated Article 14 of the Accommodation Counseling Measures in the 112th academic year, regardless of whether the penalty was eviction or other deduction methods, will cancel the accommodation qualification for the 113th academic year.

IV. Other:

New students and transfer students (Bachelor's, Master's, and Ph.D.) for the 113th academic year will be announced separately on the Housing Service Section website for application.

Room adjustments (changing rooms) are carried out every academic year. During the winter and summer vacations, when leaving the dormitory, please pack your personal belongings neatly and take them with you. If you apply for winter and summer vacation accommodation, it will be centrally managed by the Housing Service Section. Rooms will be arranged by the Housing Service Section. It is recommended not to apply if you cannot comply.
